DAFM authorised officers will carry out inspections and have powers to inspect records and documents. Failure to register the transfer of ownership within the time limit is now a serious offence in Ireland and attracts heavy penalties. Giving false, misleading or incomplete information is also a legal offence.
 WHEN BUYING / ACQUIRING OWNERSHIP: You must receive the passport from the seller at the time of purchase. You must complete this transfer of ownership form. You must forward this form and the passport with the appropriate fee to the PIO within 30 days of taking ownership.
